Communication

Thank you to School Council for assisting with the purchase of our student agendas. Agendas are an important organizational tool and an excellent form of communication between home and school. Anaphylaxis, Medical Information, Concussions

Some children in our school have life-threatening reactions to certain foods including nuts. We cannot guarantee that traces of these products aren't found in certain foods, however we are asking for your cooperation in helping keep these children healthy. Please do not send in food items containing nuts. Check food labels to determine if these items are hidden in products. Please also avoid nut butter imitations that may be safe but are indistinguishable from those that are not. If you child has a medical condition including allergy, asthma and you have not contacted the school, please let us know as soon as possible.

It is also extremely important for parents/guardians to let the school know if their child has any other **medical condition** that could impact their day to day health. Schools also have **concussion protocols** in place so if your child is being treated for a concussion, please notify the school. We would like to be aware if a child has had a previous concussion as well to ensure that we communicate that to EMS in case it could be of help in treating an injury.

Asthma

If you have not already done so, please contact the school as soon as possible **if your child has asthma**. If you are a parent/guardian of a child with asthma, we need your co-operation in providing the school with current medical information and in developing a plan to protect your child. Students under 16 years of age who have parental permission are permitted to carry their own asthma medication with them at school.

Bussing

If you would like to make changes to your child's busing, contact the Sudbury Student Consortium at 1-877-225-1196. Changes made in the last weeks of August may not be in place by school start-up. It is also a good idea to inform your child's bus driver if you are aware of upcoming changes, Please also contact the Sudbury Student Consortium and inform your child's bus driver if your child has a life-threatening allergy, asthma, or any other medical condition that might affect his/her daily health.
